FIRE PERMIT REQUIRED FOR ANY BURNING!!!

Don't forget to get your free permit, valid for 30 days at a time. The permit is required for any fires outdoors, even for roasting marshmallows!

if someone reports smoke, the fire department can check whether there is a permit for the property without having to come out to check.

In the event of another burn ban:

Call the fire department during office hours or 911 at other times to report any burning or fireworks. This is the direction provided from a senior officer at the fire station. Some residents disobeyed the burn ban in May/June 2023 but we didn't have a number to call during non-office hours.

DID YOU KNOW??

- On April 8, 2024, part of Canada will witness a total solar eclipse. During this celestial event, the Moon will align perfectly between Earth and the Sun, casting its shadow on our planet. As a result, temporary darkness will sweep across parts of the country, captivating countless spectators. The path of totality will pass through cities and towns in Southern Ontario, Southern Quebec, New Brunswick, Nova Scotia, Prince Edward Island, and Newfoundland. People outside this path will still be able to observe a partial solar eclipse, during which the Sun won't be completely hidden. It's a rare and spectacular phenomenon that hasn't graced Quebec in over 50 years, and it'll be more than 80 years before the next one occurs in 2106! **Don't watch without protective glasses!!!!**

- TAKE CARE OF YOUR PETS DURING THE ECLIPSE!**

- Keep Them inside with blinds or curtains drawn, according to advice from vets.**

Important Reminders

- If you are having visitors who are bringing a boat with them, please let them know about our boat washing rules. Boats can be washed with a power washer and vinegar, lemon juice, borax or baking soda. Do not use harsh chemicals or acids!!!! Regardless of where you wash your boat, the harsh solutions will seep into the lake.**
- If replacing your dock, please dismantle and remove old one. People are just leaving their old docks in the water, which allows any chemicals from the wood to leach into the water. They also pose a safety hazard.**
- Fireworks are illegal in Sainte Agathe des Monts! Fireworks disturb everyone, especially children and pets and their usage may be reported to the fire department.**

Constitue une nuisance et est prohibé le fait de faire usage d'une arme à feu ou d'une arme à air comprimé à moins de 500 mètres de toute maison, bâtiment ou édifice.
